## Joe's Jots

**One Word.** With today's lesson, we begin a five-week mini-series on life's challenges. Here's our schedule for Sunday mornings in October:

October 8 Suffering
October 15 Shame
October 22 Guilt
October 29 Grief

We'll look at how the gospel of Jesus Christ speaks to each of these common struggles. These lessons will be highly practical so invite friends and family members to join us! And on October 29, Alex and I will jointly present the sermon on grief.

**Church Shooting.** A nightmare scenario came to life last Sunday when a gunman opened fire on worshippers at the Burnette Chapel Church of Christ near Nashville. One woman was killed and several more were injured, including the preacher and his wife. How should we respond to a tragedy like this?

- Keep going to church. This event might make us fearful about going to church. We must not let it. Satan wants us to be afraid. But God's children must heed His most repeated command in the Old Testament: "Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go" (Joshua 1:9).
- 2. **Pray.** Lift up the victims. Thank God for the church usher who sprang into action to save lives. And don't neglect to pray for the shooter. May he come to see that the church loves her enemies.
- Continue to welcome the stranger. We must not allow this event to keep us from being hospitable to outsiders. It's ok to be cautious and diligent. It's not acceptable to close ourselves off from a world that needs the gospel.
