## Joe's Jots

**Time in the Word.** This holiday season, many of you will be blessed with time off from work. I challenge you to use some of that spare time in God's Word. Here are a couple ideas you may not have considered:



**1. Read an entire book of the Bible in one sitting.** This is how many of the books of the Bible were originally intended to be read. Reading a book in one sitting will ensure that you keep verses and chapters in their proper context. It will also help you grasp the overall theme of a book. Think you don't have time? Most Bible books can be read in less time it takes to watch a movie. And you can read some in far less time. For instance, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians and Colossians can each be read in less than 30 minutes!

**2. Listen to the Word.** Many of you have smartphones with the YouVersion Bible app. If you do, you have the capability of listening to the Word. The letters of the New Testament were probably heard before they were read. And Christians for generations did not own personal copies of the Bible and had to rely on hearing the word. Listening helps you gain a "big picture" perspective of a book and you can do it during other tasks like driving, walking, or doing chores.

Regardless of your method, spend time in the Word over the holidays!

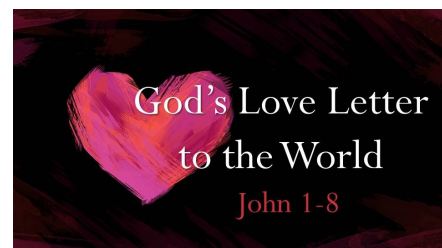
