Celebrate Women. Lydia was a prominent woman in the church at Philippi. Along with her household, she was the first convert to the gospel in that city (Acts 16:14-15). And her home became the meeting place for the early church there (Acts 16:40). In the letter to the Philippians, two more prominent Christian women are mentioned. Their names are Euodia and Synteche and Paul says they "labored side by side" with him in the gospel (Phil. 4:2-3). These examples remind us how important women were in the ministry of Paul. They should also remind us how important women are to be in the life of the church today. When I think about the pillars of our congregation, I not only think about our elders, deacons, and other mature men of the faith. I also think about several of our ladies who have worshipped and served God here for many years. Yet, because men and women have different God-given roles, and more specifically because God has called men to spiritual leadership to which women should submit, women are often demeaned and made to feel insignificant by the church. To use the words of James from a different context, "My brothers, this ought not to be so!" Men's and women's roles may be different, but one set is not better or more valuable than the other. Both are vital! Therefore, the women of the church and the contributions they make to the Kingdom should always be celebrated!
